1. Digantar Vidyalayas

Digantar Vidyalayas serve as practical sites where innovative educational practices and theoretical perspectives are implemented and observed. The two schools currently operating under Digantar – one primary school at *Kho Raibariyan* with 50 students and 2 teachers, and another at *Bhavgarh Bandhya* with 176 students and 7 teachers; are not just providing quality education to underprivileged children but also serving as training sites for education professionals and student-teachers.

Planned Projects

1. Digantar Vidyalaya Vision 2030

Digantar Vidyalaya Vision 2030 embodies a transformative approach to education, aiming to address pressing societal challenges in India through quality education and community engagement. Central to Vision 2030 is the consolidation of two schools into a single, self-sustaining institution by 2030. Through a special and innovative model of a Parent Teacher Association (PTA), it aims to educate 50% of under privileged children without charge through the engagement of 50% fee - paying parents (and their friends and associates, maybe), demonstrating the possibility that parents and individuals in the local society can contribute significantly to enabling such a school to be self-supporting while participating actively in the management of the school.

This is a three Phase project:

- 1. Phase One (Dec '23 to June '24) completed a comprehensive feasibility study, exploring parental expectations and educational needs. The study is funded by Monsoon Accessorize Trust, UK.
- 2. Phase Two (June '24 to March '25) focuses on preparation, including recruitment of teachers and their capacity building, infrastructure development, and securing necessary approvals.
- **3. Phase Three (April '25 to March '31)** marks the implementation stage, transforming the school into a unified, self-sustaining entity by the end of the financial year 2030-31.
